

One Stone Advisors: Responsible Lobbying Policy

Approach

One Stone engages in a limited, values-led form of advocacy. We will only lobby, or support the lobbying of others, where doing so contributes to a positive impact on society or the environment. Our lobbying positions are based on reliable and/or scientific evidence, rather than narrow commercial interest.

Our current lobbying activity is our support for the Better Business Act, the campaign led by B Lab UK to reform Section 172 of the Companies Act 2006 so that directors are required to consider the interests of people, communities and the environment alongside shareholders. Any other lobbying or advocacy we undertake, now or in future, is held to the same standard set out in this policy.

Financial and Political Contributions

One Stone Advisors does not make financial or in-kind contributions to political parties, elected representatives, or candidates for political office.

Anti-corruption & Bribery

Our approach to lobbying is governed by the same anti-bribery and anti-corruption commitments set out in our Code of Conduct: we do not offer, give, solicit or accept bribes, and we expect the same of anyone we engage with on advocacy matters.

Intermediary Organisations

Our primary lobbying-related engagement is through our support of the Better Business Act, coordinated by B Lab UK. We do not hold a governance position within this campaign or provide funding beyond our support as a signatory, and we view our involvement as values-aligned rather than strategic influence-seeking. Because the Better Business Act's aims align directly with our own purpose, we do not currently have a conflicting position to disclose. If that changes, or if we engage with any other intermediary organisation – such as a trade body or industry association – whose lobbying position conflicts with this policy, we will publicly state our position relative to theirs, how we are seeking to influence them, and the circumstances that would lead us to end that engagement.

Publication, Reporting & Review

This policy is approved by Fran van Dijk, CEO and highest governing body of One Stone Advisors Ltd, and is formally reviewed at least every 36 months. Fran is responsible for reviewing any new advocacy activity against this policy before it is undertaken.

This policy is published on our website and accessible to all stakeholders. From Year 3, we will publish an annual summary of our lobbying positions and any political contributions made in the preceding fiscal year.

Stakeholders who have concerns about our lobbying practices or wider business conduct can raise them through One Stone's Grievance Procedure.
